A Scheme for the Shelf Arrangement of Library Materials in the Field of
Alternative and Complementary Medicine
within the Framework of the NLM Classification

- QV 748 Prescription writing. Dosage. NLM
(Include herbal dosages & formulations) NEW
- QV 752 Pharmacognosy. Natural history of drugs. NLM
- QV 754 Collection and preservation of drugs. NLM
Identification, growing collection (wildcrafting) and preservation
of medicinal plants. Herb gardening. NEW
- QV 760 Materia medica NLM
which contain both allopathic drugs and herbal preparations NEW
- QV 766 Medicinal plants (General without geographic application). NLM
- QV 767 Herbs (General, popular works, herbals)
- QV 767.5 Herbs NLM
Monographs on singular medicinal plants cuttered alphabetically
by herb name. Use common name only if better known than the
Latin name. NEW
(Establish subject headings / authority records for each new
cuttered remedy.)
